Safety measure

Precautions should be revised in the package insert.

In the Contraindications section, the following language concerning patients receiving adrenaline or clozapine should be revised (revised language is underlined):

Patients receiving adrenaline (except when adrenaline is used for the emergency treatment of anaphylaxis) or clozapine

In the Contraindications for Co-administration subsection of the Interactions section, the following language concerning adrenaline should be revised (revised language is underlined):

Adrenaline (except when used for the emergency treatment of anaphylaxis)
*Haloperidol decanoate and risperidone (injections) are designated as a drug requiring preparation of a Drug Guide for Patients.

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
