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Prof. Vinks is the Cincinnati Children's Research Foundation Endowed Chair in Clinical Pharmacology and Professor of Pediatrics and Pharmacology at the University of Cincinnati, College of Medicine. He is Director of the Division of Clinical Pharmacology and serves as the Program Director of the Postdoctoral Training Program (T32) in Pediatric Clinical Pharmacology at Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center.

He is co-director of Cincinnati Children's Genetic Pharmacology Program and directs a multidisciplinary Pharmacometrics Program. Dr. Vinks received his academic training at Leiden University and the University of Toronto. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Clinical Pharmacology and a Fellow of the American College of Clinical Pharmacology. He is past president of the International Association of Therapeutic Drug Monitoring and Clinical Toxicology. Dr. Vinks serves on several editorial boards including Therapeutic Drug Monitoring and is an Associate Editor for Clinical Pharmacology & Therapeutics.

His research interests include systems pharmacology, physiologically-based pharmacokinetics (PBPK), pharmacogenetics/genomics, pharmacokinetic-pharmacodynamic (PK/PD) modeling and the application of population and simulation methods to inform clinical trial design and therapeutic drug management.
