Precautions should be revised in the package insert.

In the Precautions of Dosage and Administration section information on drugs to be used in combination, the following text should be revised (underlined parts are revised):

Caution should be exercised on drugs to be used in combination for the following category. In addition, drugs as combination therapy that are not known to affect the glucuronidation of lamotrigine should follow the dosage and administration of lamotrigine concomitantly used with sodium valproate.

Drugs that do not affect the glucuronidation of lamotrigine are as follows:

Aripiprazole, olanzapine, zonisamide, gabapentin, cimetidine, topiramate, pregabalin, lithium, levetiracetam, perampanel, and lacosamide
