Safety measure

Precautions should be revised in the package insert.

In the Clinically significant adverse reaction subsection regarding hepatitis, hepatic function disorder, and jaundice of the Adverse reaction section, the following text should be revised (underlined parts are revised):

Fulminant hepatitis, hepatitis, hepatic function disorder, and jaundice:

Fulminant hepatitis, hepatitis, hepatic function disorder, or jaundice may occur.

Patients should be carefully monitored. If any abnormalities are observed, administration of this drug should be discontinued and appropriate measures should be adopted.

In the Clinically significant adverse reaction subsection regarding rhabdomyolysis of the Adverse reaction section, the following text should be revised (underlined parts are revised):

Rhabdomyolysis:

Rhabdomyolysis characterized by myalgia, feelings of weakness, increased creatinine kinase (creatinine phosphokinase), or increased blood and urine myoglobin may occur.

Patients should be carefully monitored. If these symptoms are observed, administration of this drug should be discontinued immediately and appropriate measures should be adopted.

In addition, caution should be exercised for development of acute kidney injury due to rhabdomyolysis.

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
