Precautions should be revised in the package insert.

The language concerning toxic epidermal necrolysis, oculomucocutaneous syndrome, and exfoliative dermatitis in the Clinically Significant Adverse Reactions subsection of the Adverse Reactions section should be revised as follows (revised language is underlined):

Toxic epidermal necrolysis (TEN), oculomucocutaneous syndrome (Stevens-Johnson syndrome), <u>acute generalized exanthematous pustulosis</u>, or exfoliative dermatitis:

Toxic epidermal necrolysis, oculomucocutaneous syndrome, <u>acute generalized</u>

<u>exanthematous pustulosis</u>, or exfoliative dermatitis may occur. Patients should be carefully monitored and if such symptoms are observed, administration of this drug should be discontinued and appropriate measures should be taken.
