




In the JP, chemical names are named according to the systematic nomenclature prescribed by IUPAC. However, natural products and related compounds may be named semi-systematically using a trivial name as the name of basic parent structure to indicate similarity, and compounds having the following parent structures are named based on the trivial name in several monographs.
